

In a nutshell we (fundraising Shoalhaven Inc) are hosting a Charity Concert featuring Shane Howard (Of Goanna band fame) at Coolangatta Estate on the 10th May 2019. Our charter is to create and run events, and to distribute all profits to local charities. In the case of this event, all proceeds are to be directed to **A Taste of Paradise Organic Farm at Berry.**

Back Arm Band, a national Australian ensemble that brought together some of the most influential Aboriginal artists to tour Australia and the world. Ireland, Australia, New Zealand, Holland, Canada and the US.

On Shane's 61st birthday, Australia Day, 26 January 2016 he was appointed a Member of the Order of Australia for significant service to the performing arts as a singer, songwriter and guitarist to the recording industry, and to Indigenous musicians

Karina Seyffer from Fundraising Shoalhaven said the organisation was delighted to be able to assist A Taste of Paradise by bringing an artist of Howard's stature to Coolangatta Estate.

"This is a really worthwhile organisation that is doing great work with disadvantaged young people in our community. The charity doesn't receive direct government funding, and really needs additional funds to help them continue," Ms Seyffer said. "We are very grateful to Coolangatta Estate for providing such a great venue, and really hope that the people rally to help A Taste of Paradise by coming to the show."

From the President;

Great meeting last week. We heard from Caitlin Barrett and Rebecca Stanley from Love Mercy Uganda. We saw the result of the money we sent to them with 3 new wells with plaques on them identifying the Berry Rotary Club. The bores provide clean water for a number of villages in Northern Uganda replacing the usual dodgy water supplies and the accompanying water borne diseases.



Caitlin also spoke on the Cents for Seeds program. That is such an innovative idea and to think Caitlin was largely instrumental in getting all this going. It makes you proud that as the Rotary Club of Berry we are able to assist in this. She stated that more bores are needed as the area missed one of its two wet seasons causing a drought which meant crops sown were not harvested. This is a devastating result for families with no back up living from one harvest to the next.

After the meeting the Board held an impromptu meeting and resolved to take some of the funds from the Berry Small Farm Field day and other accumulated funds to fund 2 more bores as they had identified a further 5 villages in urgent need for a well and only had funding in place for one of these.

One of the huge benefits of being in Rotary is you can be a part of changing the world and see where your funds are going. While I appreciate what NGOs are doing around the world and the trials they face, sending a cheque just doesn't seem the same as hearing the talk we heard last meeting and being able to act on it.
